Spiritual Gift Definitions

- A. **PROPHECY**: The gift of prophecy is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to receive and communicate an immediate message of God to help His people through a divinely-anointed utterance.
- B. **SERVING**: The gift of service is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to identify the unmet needs involved in a task related to God's work. Members with this gift are able to make use of available resources to meet those needs and help accomplish the desired goals.
- C. **HELPS**: The gift of helps is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to invest the talents they have in the life and ministry of other members of the body. Thus enabling them to increase the effectiveness of their own spiritual gifts.
- D. **TEACHING**: The gift of teaching is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to communicate information, relevant to the health and ministry of the body and its members. Members with this gift are able to do this in such a way that others will learn.
- E. **EXHORTATION**: The gift of exhortation is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to minister words of comfort, consolation, encouragement and counsel to other members of the body. Members with this gift are able to do this in such a way that others feel helped and healed.
- F. **GIVING**: The gift of giving is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to contribute their material resources to the work of the Lord with liberality and cheerfulness.
- G. **LEADERSHIP**: The gift of leadership is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to set goals in accordance with God's purpose for the future of the church. Members with this gift are able to communicate these goals to others in such a way that they voluntarily and harmoniously work together to accomplish these goals for the glory of God.
- H. **ADMINISTRATION**: The gift of administration is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to clearly understand the immediate and long-range goals of a particular unit of the body of Christ. Members with this gift are able to devise and execute effective plans for the accomplishment of those goals.
- I. **MERCY**: The gift of mercy is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to feel genuine empathy and compassion for individuals, both Christian and non-Christian, who suffer distressing physical, mental or emotional problems. Members with this special gift are able to translate that compassion into cheerfully done deeds, which reflect Christ's love and alleviate the suffering.
- J. **WISDOM**: The gift of wisdom is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to know the mind of the Holy Spirit. Members with this gift are able to receive insight into how given knowledge may best be applied to specific needs arising in the body of Christ.

- K. KNOWLEDGE:** The gift of knowledge is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to discover, accumulate, analyze and clarify information and ideas which are pertinent to the growth and well-being of the body.
- L. FAITH:** The gift of faith is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to discern with extraordinary confidence the will and purposes of God for the future of His work.
- M. DISCERNMENT:** The gift of discerning of spirits is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to know with assurance whether certain behavior, purported to be of God, is in reality divine, human or Satanic.
- N. EVANGELIST:** The gift of evangelist is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to share the Gospel with unbelievers. Members with this gift are able to do this in such a way that men and women become Jesus' disciples and responsible members of the body of Christ.
- O. PASTOR - SHEPHERDING:** The gift of pastor is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to assume a long-term, personal responsibility for the spiritual welfare of a group of believers.
- P. HOSPITALITY:** The gift of hospitality is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to provide an open house and warm welcome for those in need of food and lodging.
- Q. MISSIONARY:** The gift of missionary is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the body of Christ to minister their other spiritual gifts in a second culture.
